Austin has designated the bridge an Austin Landmark and it is a Registered Historic Place. The bridge's six art deco spandrels reflect in perfect symmetry upon the waters of Lady Bird Lake.

Cuvée '42 Pinot Noir demonstrates the same balance and artistry upon your palate. 100% Pinot Noir blended from four of the finest vineyards in Sonoma County. A beautiful expression of Sonoma County representing the Russian River Valley, Sonoma Mountain and the Petaluma Gap.
