



2021 Rosé of Pinot Noir

Sonoma County / Monterey County

Founded in 2014, Roger & Donna Beery along with their children, Conch and Whitney set upon a calling for their rich family history, mutual respect for honesty and integrity in winemaking. Along with consulting winemaker Adam Lee, J. Cage Cellars honors two generations with one passion. Their philosophy is traditional and non-interventionist and they believe winemaking begins in the vineyard, while sourcing from small family growers that are some of the most respected in Sonoma County.

A deliciously layered Pinot Noir Rosé that can be enjoyed solo or paired with a multitude of summer fare. Aromas of ripe strawberry and watermelon are the prelude to a refreshing yet rich mouth-feel. On the palate, the balanced acidity dances with red berries and watermelon with a touch of raspberry and vanilla in the long finish.

100% Pinot Noir – 62% of the fruit came from a small Russian River Valley vineyard. The fruit was picked, destemmed and gently pressed within a few hours, specifically for Rosé. 38% is Pinot saignée from famed Gary's Vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands. The wine was aged in a combination of stainless steel and neutral French oak with about 50% Malolactic fermentation.
