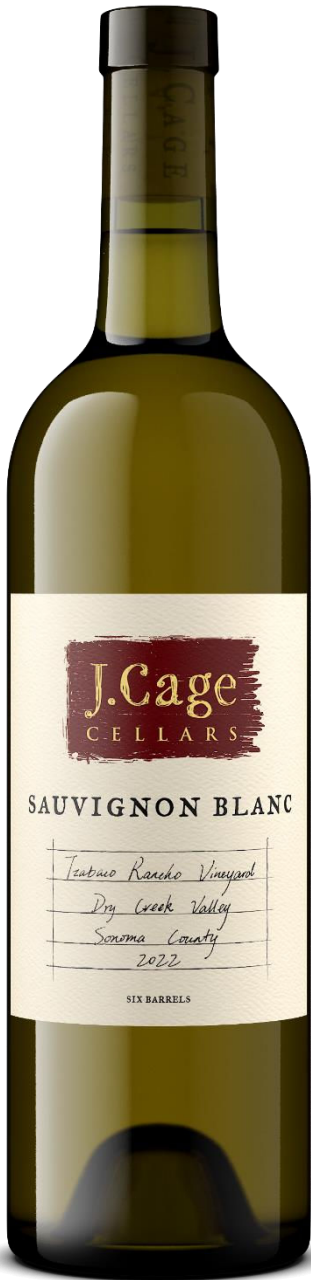

Beautifully fragrant nose offering notes of citrus, Meyer lemon and ripe pineapple. A perfect balance of brisk acidity and luxurious mouthfeel. Your palate will enjoy the cacophony of refreshing flavors including, peach, rich tropical, ripe pineapple, Meyer lemon, wet stone minerality with just the slightest hint of white tea.

100% Sauvignon Blanc blended of 45% Sauvignon Blanc Clone 1 and 55% Sauvignon Blanc Musque Clone. The grapes were specifically chosen for their rich flavor profile and hand harvested. The wine was aged 50% in neutral French oak and 50% in stainless steel and is 100% dry.
